COMPULSORY BUILDING FUND LEVY

An annual levy is charged per family to contribute to the capital costs of college infrastructure. This compulsory Building Levy is not tax deductible. In addition to this compulsory levy, families are welcome to donate funds to MCC Building Fund. Donations \$2 and over to the College Building Fund are tax deductible.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS

A sibling discount on tuition fees applies to families that have more than one student attending the College. (College levies do not attract a discount.) Sibling discount is structured as follows:

TRADE TRAINING CENTRE (Year 11 & 12)

Single Pathway - TTC offers a single pathway option for those students who are not necessarily seeking a job in the trade industry. Students will complete a Cert II in Engineering Pathways. This cost is included in the college levies.

Trade Pathway - Students will be required to complete Building & Construction Skills, Cert II in Engineering Pathways and Industrial Graphics. Trade Pathway incurs a separate levy of:

OTHER CHARGES

Extra-Curricular Activities - These activities are an integral element of College life and students are encouraged to be involved. Activities are held outside school hours and are arranged by the College. Depending on the activity, students may be required to pay an additional fee.

Creative Academy - Individual instrument tuition as arranged with instructor. Payment required at the start of each term. Billed separately from Creative Academy.

FEE DESCRIPTION

WHAT DO SCHOOL FEES INCLUDE?

School Fees cover the cost of tuition, workbooks and textbooks (digital and hardcopy), educational programs and resources, educational licence fees, sports carnivals, library resources, some visiting performances and guest speakers and College celebration events.

Also included are online subjects and Vocational Education Certificates:

- Up to two vocational education certificates where articulated in the Senior Subject Selection Guide, and/or
- One online General or Applied subject, if articulated in the school's Senior Subject Selection Guide. Second online General or Applied subjects will be on-charged.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

School fees are billed annually and our two different methods of payment are as follows:

OPTION 1: Up Front Payment

For full-fee paying families, a **5% discount** on Tuition Fees applies when Annual Fees are fully paid by 31 March. This discount does not apply to students starting part way through the year. OPTION 2: Payment Plan to conclude by End of Term 4

For all other families, a payment plan must be arranged by the 28 February, paying the balance in full by the End of Term 4. We encourage you to setup **the payment plan via Parent Lounge**. To establish your Payment Schedule please visit Parent Lounge, select "Accounts & Payments" and follow the prompts.

CONCESSION CARD DISCOUNT

A Concession Card Discount is offered to families who hold a current 'means tested' Government Health Care or Pensioner Concession card. Eligible card holders are required to provide the College with a copy of their concession card at enrolment, after which a 30% discount will be applied to the tuition fees of all eligible students from the family.
