## On dayone, students will need:

Coloured pencils and textas (Year 7 only)

- 1 Kent set (small tin with set square, protractor, compass) (Years 7 and 8 only)
- 2 HB lead pencils
- 2 blue ball-point pens
- 2 red ball-point pens
- 4 highlighters (assorted colours)
- 1 large Bostik glue stick
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 white-out correction tape (not fluid)
- 1 barrel pencil sharpener (no toys or gadgets please)
- 1 eraser (no toys)
- 1 wooden ruler (no metal or flexible rulers)
- 1 large pencil case to hold writing items
- 1 scientific calculator (please see note below)
- 1 soft cleaning cloth to clean laptop/iPad screen
- 1 power bank to charge laptop/iPad (laptops require usb C PD output min 65w output however 100w is recommended, capacity 20000mAh(min) recommended 25000mAh)
- 1 set of headphones named (not earbud) with iPad connection for classroom and NAPLAN online test
- 1 Bible (New Living Translation) hard copy required and available from the School Locker

#### **Approved Electronic Learning Device**

From 2026, Year 7 students are issued a College laptop through to Year 9 that has been preconfigured with the College management system and security, and loaded with all required software programs. This laptop is intended for educational use only. The laptop comes with a case, charger and 3-year warranty with accidental damage protection. Excess fees will apply to accidental protection claims and claims are limited each year. Students should carry the laptop in the case provided when not in use. If the laptop is damaged or not working, it must be taken to the College ICT Department in the TLE Block for assessment and repairs. Newly enrolled students in Years 8 and 9 will also be issued with a College owned laptop. Previously enrolled Years 8 and 9 students will continue to use their iPad.

## **CALCULATORS**

Scientific calculators will be used in class and may be purchased from the School Locker.

The model recommended is Casio FX-82AU PLUS II (first or second edition).

#### **OTHER INFORMATION**

- Some of these items may need to be replaced during the year to ensure ongoing supply of equipment e.g. pens, pencils, etc.
- A list of additional stationery items specific to a student's class will be given early in Term 1.
- Almost all other requirements are provided by the College for Years 7 to 9.
- To encourage healthy eating habits, we encourage parents to avoid the following convenience foods as much as possible in children's lunches: chips, lollies, rollups, soft drinks, chocolate or chocolate products.

## **Years 10 to 12 Student Stationery List**

### On day one, students will need:

- 1 A4 exercise book for Year 11 and 12 Physical Education and each Years 11 and 12 Maths, Science, English, and Humanities subject (exercise books are provided for Year 10 students)
- 2 HB lead pencils
- 2 red ball-point pens
- 2 blue ball-point pens
- 4 highlighters (assorted colours)
- 1 barrel pencil sharpener (no toys or gadgets please)
- 1 eraser (no toys)
- 1 wooden ruler (no metal or flexible rulers)
- 1 large Bostik glue stick
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 white-out correction tape (not fluid)
- 1 large pencil case to hold writing items
- 1 pad of graph paper
- 1 A4 ring binder (25mm)
- 1 packet of plastic A4 pockets
- 2 packets of 5 tab A4 dividers
- 2 packets of lined A4 loose leaf paper
- 1 scientific calculator or graphics calculator (please see information below)
- 1 sturdy, tough iPad case or lap top bag to help minimise potential damage (please see information below)
- 1 soft cleaning cloth to clean laptop/iPad screen
- 1 power bank to charge laptop/iPad (laptops require usb C PD output min 65w output however 100w is recommended, capacity 20000mAh(min) recommended 25000mAh)
- 1 set of headphones named (not earbud) with iPad connection
- 1 Bible (New Living Translation) hard copy required and available from the School Locker

#### **Approved Electronic Learning Device**

Years 10 - 12 students have the option to bring their own laptop, if preferred. Laptops must be Wi-Fi enabled (minimum recommendation for wireless as 5GHz compatible (802.11n/ac/ax) and capable of running Windows 11, Microsoft 365 and Adobe Creative Cloud. Students in Year 11 and 12 who are ATAR eligible are required to complete substantial assignments in several of their subjects and should choose the laptop option. The College advises that as a minimum requirement, laptops are equipped with an Intel Core i5 10th generation CPU, 16GB of RAM, 5GHz (802.11n/ac/ax) compatible and a drive with at least 256GB storage. BYOD laptops should be running Windows 11 or, if a BYOD Mac, be able to receive software updates from Apple. BYOD devices should have current antivirus software installed (Macs included), with free versions being readily accessible. The College may install configuration applications to setup Wi-Fi and Office365 access.

Year 10-12 students choosing an **iPad** must provide a full-sized iPad, with a minimum of 64GB storage and Wi-Fi connectivity. iPads must be able to receive support Apple updates and be 5GHz (802.11n/ac/ax) compatible (normally less than three years old). The iPad 'Pro' with Wi-Fi connectivity is acceptable, however it is more expensive to purchase. The iPad 'Mini' is not permitted as the screen size makes it unsuitable for learning. The use of cloud technologies provided by the College enables students to supplement an iPad with other devices at home, if preferred.

#### **CALCULATORS**

Year 10 students and Years 11 and 12 General Mathematics and Essential Mathematics students require a scientific calculator. Scientific calculators may be purchased from the School Locker. The model recommended is Casio FX-82AU PLUS II (first or second edition).

Years 11 and 12 Mathematical Methods and Specialist Maths Students require a TI Nspire CX II non CAS graphics calculator. These can be leased from MCC for \$40.00 per year. Payments can be made at the College Office. Students take their receipt to the Library to get their calculator. Note: students may also purchase their own TINspire CX CAS II model which has the "Press to Test" feature.
