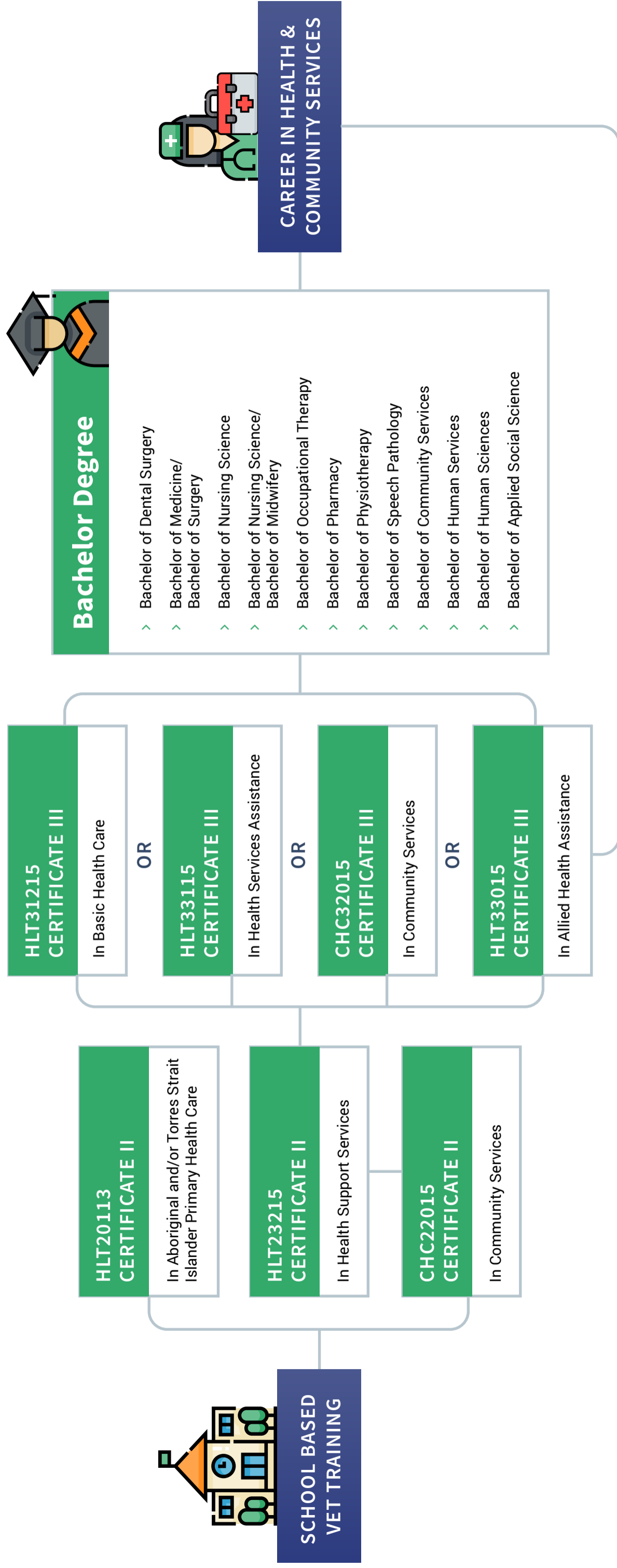
HEALTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES

At this level workers complete tasks under supervision involving known routines and procedures or complete routine but variable tasks in collaboration with others in a team environment.</p> <p>Community Services May be used as a pathway for workforce entry as community services workers provide a first point of contact and assist individuals in meeting their immediate needs.
