COURSE INFORMATION

The Mackay Christian College Trade Training Centre (MCCTTC) offers a unique, co-educational program for Year 11 & 12 students who would like to add foundational, practical understanding and abilities to their skills set or who are pursuing a trade career. With strong industry links, experienced staff and a purpose-built facility, the MCCTTC allows students to develop their trade skills while working toward their Queensland Certificate of Education.

MCCTTC is operated by Mackay Christian College with the support of its consortium partners Whitsunday Anglican School and Carlisle Adventist Christian College. To access any of the Trade Training Centre programs, students must be enrolled in a consortium school.

MCCTTC has a strong focus on work readiness, providing students with industry exposure to inform their career pathways and develop their employability skills. A proven student support service helps students achieve success in their core studies while gaining a Vocational Certificate and/ or engaging in a School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeship.

Industry value work experience highly and have provided feedback that they would like to see a minimum of two work experience placements on a student's resume over their three years of senior schooling. MCCTTC provides opportunity for fulltime students to complete a minimum of seven work experience placements during Years 11 & 12.

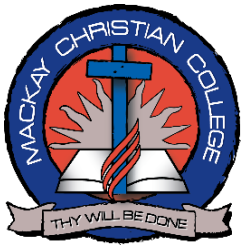

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The MCCTTC seeks to target two groups of students:

Trade Pathway Students Those who are seeking to graduate from Year 12 into an Engineering or Construction trade career.

MCCTTC Trade Pathway Students will graduate with Certificate I in Construction and a Certificate II in Engineering Pathways. In addition to these nationally recognised qualifications, MCCTTC Trade Pathway students and staff will work towards securing a future in the students preferred trade area through an Australian School based Apprenticeship (ASbA).

Single Subject Pathway Students Those who are considering university entrance or another career pathway.

MCCTTC Single Subject Pathway Students are those who participate in the Trade Training Centre by selecting TTC as only one of their senior subjects. These students remain eligible to attend university after senior. Here they can develop some practical skills in the TTC while completing five other academic subjects. Students may choose to undertake either a Certificate I in Construction or Certificate II in Engineering Pathways as one of their subject electives. Students will go to school as normal and attend the TTC in the time allocated on the time table.

ENROLMENT PROCESS

MCCTTC Trade Pathway and Single Subject Pathway students need to:

- Be enrolled in a consortium school
- Complete an "Expression of Interest" form
- Attend an interview arranged by MCCTTC staff

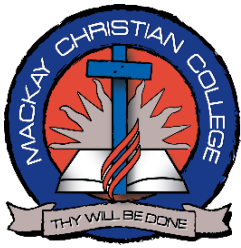

College Fees

Trade Training Centre students will be subject to standard fees at the school of their enrolment.

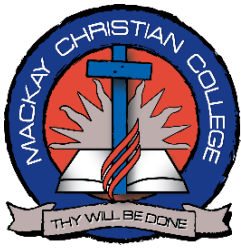
MCCTTC Trade Pathway Subject Levy - The MCCTTC Trade Pathway program is specifically tailored to meet the current needs of industry and to equip and prepare students for their preferred career choice. Students will be required to complete Certificate I in Construction, Certificate II in Engineering Pathways along with Industrial Graphics. Trade Pathway has a separate levy charged in place of the subject levy.

\$179.50/term (\$718/year) (5% discount if paid in full by 31st March - \$35.90)

MCCTCC Single Subject Pathway - MCCTTC also offers a Single Pathway option to students who are not necessarily seeking a job in the trade industry. Students can select either Certificate I in Construction or Certificate II in Engineering Pathways. This levy is included in the Year level subject levy.

Whitsunday Anglican School & Carlisle Adventist Christian College Single Pathway Subject Levy

The Single Pathway Levy will be \$40 per month.

Uniform Policy

All MCCTTC students must own a formal dress uniform from the school of their enrolment.

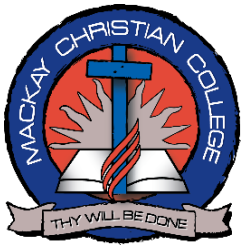

Whitsunday Anglican School and **Carlisle Adventist Christian College** students will have the opportunity to change before class on return to their College.

MCCTTC Uniform Requirements

- Orange/Navy Long Sleeve Hi Vis Shirt **embroidered with the approved MCCTCC Logo**
- Navy Long Drill Cargo Pants
- Navy Short Drill Cargo Pants – Construction students ONLY
- Navy Work Socks
- Canvas and Mesh Broad Brim Hat – Construction students ONLY
- Black Safety Boots - Lace-up, High Ankle with safety toes - Safety Boots are to coincide with the college uniform policy of black school shoes. However, if your child currently owns safety boots of a different colour, please discuss options with Director of Trade Training Centre in an effort to minimise the initial setup cost of uniforms. Elastic sided boots are not acceptable.

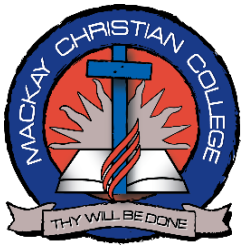

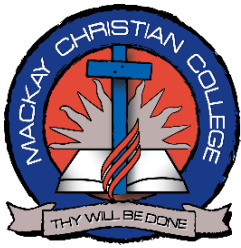
Option 1 Both Tool Kits can be purchased through MCCTTC
