

Outside School Hours (OSH) Care Educator

Position Overview

The OSHC Educator is responsible for providing a safe, inclusive and engaging environment for children attending before-school, after-school and vacation care programs. Working as part of a team, the Educator supports the planning and implementation of high-quality programs that foster children's wellbeing, learning and development in line with the National Quality Framework (NQF), My Time, Our Place Framework and service philosophy.

Key Responsibilities

- Supervise and engage with children in a safe and positive manner during before and after school hours.
- Assist in the planning, preparation and delivery of play-based, age-appropriate activities that promote creativity, physical activity and social development.
- Build respectful and supportive relationships with children, families and colleagues.
- Ensure the environment is clean, safe and well-organised at all times.
- Support children's individual needs, interests and wellbeing.
- Follow and uphold all policies and procedures relating to child safety, behaviour management, health and hygiene.
- Contribute to daily routines, snack preparation and pack-up duties.
- Participate in staff meetings, training sessions and continuous improvement processes.
- Record attendance and maintain accurate documentation, as required.
- Actively uphold the service's philosophy, values and inclusion practices.

Qualifications and Requirements

- Minimum Certificate III or Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care (or equivalent qualification under ACECOA)
- Current Working with Children Check (WWCC) or equivalent clearance
- Current First Aid, CPR, Asthma and Anaphylaxis Management certificates
- Knowledge of the National Quality Framework (NQF) and "My Time, Our Place" framework
- Experience working with school-aged children (preferred)
- Strong communication and teamwork skills
- Commitment to child safety and wellbeing
