Students participating in this subject will strengthen creative and technical skills for a range of media practices. They will analyse how media arts works communicate meaning and think critically about media representations and their impact on audiences. They will also build confidence in planning, creating, and refining media projects as they discover pathways into creative industries and further study.
