



# MUSIC

Students will have the opportunity to develop their skills in performance and composition. Students will also explore, write and respond in preparation for musicology tasks in Years 11 and 12.

This is achieved through exploring a variety of music styles and techniques - including the study of Australian music and music through the centuries. This course also allows students the opportunity to develop their potential in their preferred area of musical expertise when performing and composing.



# VISUAL ARTS

In Year 10 Visual Arts, students explore diverse artistic practices, deepen their understanding of visual conventions, and develop critical thinking skills through analysis and evaluation of artworks and artists. They learn to manipulate materials and techniques, build personal style, and create artworks that communicate ideas. The scope and sequence also include curating and presenting exhibitions to engage audiences.

This subject will prepare students to undertake Visual Arts in Practice in Years 11 and 12.
