



Year 11 Students:

These Certificates are run in partnership with Connect 'n' Grow (RTO Code: 40518) providing students with the basic skills for a career in the health and social services industries, as well as providing a pathway for those wishing to pursue further study in these fields.

The Certificates are delivered at the college with an opportunity to engage in 20 hours of work placement at The Mater Hospital. The training is theoretical and practical, including interactive virtual reality simulated work scenarios.

Year 12 Students:

Upon successful completion of the Certificate II in Health Support Services students can continue to study the HLT33115 Certificate III in Health Services Assistance in Year 12. Students will receive recognition for units of competency already completed as part of the Certificate II studied in Year 11 that form part of the Certificate III.
